mostly dioecious, but with either a few flowers of the opposite sex or a few bisexual flowers on the same plant.

EXCLUDED

Although we do have a number plants that fall under this classification they are not listed. Primarily because they do have the ability to self-pollinate from a single plant in most cases. But the rule holds true for monoecious, dioecious and polygamo-dioecious that for best results have more than one individual plant located nearby for a healthy pollination.
